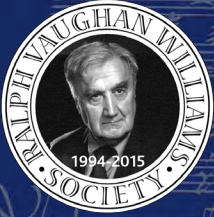

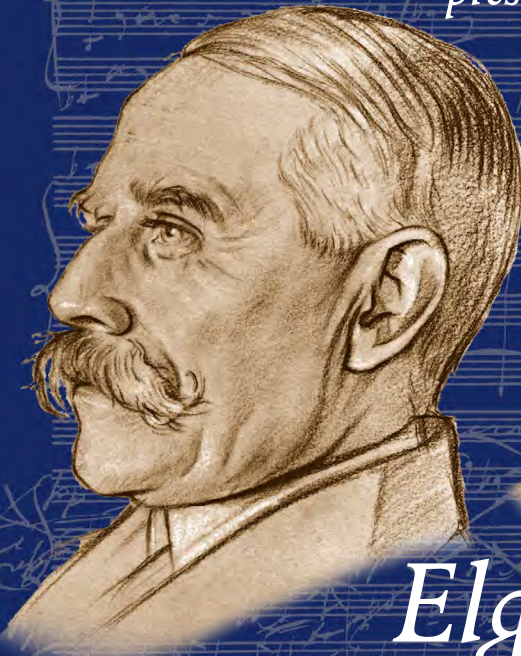

TRAVEL & ACCOMMODATION

Woodbridge is on the A12 trunk road, nine miles north-east of Ipswich, within easy reach of the picturesque Suffolk coast, and served by hourly trains from Ipswich from where there are frequent trains to London Liverpool Street, Norwich, Peterborough and Cambridge.
